Uniform and Shoe Cleaning

Updated 5/22/2023

- Uniforms and shoes need to be cleaned every week
- Jackets
 - Spot clean dirty areas ONLY with OxyClean and a toothbrush. Rinse with cold water and hang to dry – Do NOT PUT IN A WASHER
 - o If more than spot cleaning is needed, bring to a dry cleaner
 - When cleaning, unsnap the sleeves of the cuffs get clean-remember to re-snap before wearing again
 - Check for any missing or loose snaps, buttons, or closures and notify Mrs. Montana right away if any repairs are needed.
- Pants
 - Spot clean dirty areas ONLY with OxyClean and a toothbrush
 - Before washing, unsnap the legs so the cuffs are cleaned. (Make note of where they were snapped)
 - Wash in cold water ONLY NO BLEACH
 - Hang by straps to dry OR put in dryer for 10 minutes on low heat
 - Please steam press if needed. Do not iron pants without a cloth over them-they are polyester and will burn
 - Fold pants at the seams to keep creases and hang under the jacket on the hanger. Please only use one hanger in the bag.
- Shoes
 - Clean with Mr. Clean sponges (magic eraser) or use OxyClean and a toothbrush

PLEASE OPEN UNIFORM BAGS AND SHOE BAGS WHEN THEY COME HOME TO AIR OUT-ESPECIALLY IF IT RAINS OR ARE WET FROM DEW.
